



## *T-ROH ALLIANCE*

### 1. Name

1.1- The club shall be called T-ROH ALLIANCE, and operates as a trust, and

### 2. Aims and objectives

The aims and objectives of the club are:

- To provide a communications network for its members
- To promote the awareness of human rights
- To ensure a duty of care to all members of the club
- To provide all its services in a way that is fair to everyone
- To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment

### 3. Membership

3.1- Membership should consist of officers and members of the club. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the club has adopted.

3.2- Members will be enrolled in one of the following categories:

- Associate Member

### 4. Membership fees

4.1- Membership fees will be set annually and determined at the Annual General Meeting.

4.2- Fees will be paid by annual subscription to cover the costs of the communications network.

## 5. Officers of the club

5.1- The officers of the club will be:

- Chair
- Vice Chair
- Honorary Secretary
- Treasurer
- Mapping Co-ordinator
- Publicity Officer

5.2- Officers will be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting. Committee members may not serve in the same position for more than three years.

## 6. Committee

6.1- The club will be managed through the Management Committee consisting of:

- Chair
- Vice Chair
- Honorary Secretary
- Treasurer
- Mapping Co-ordinator
- Publicity Officer

6.2- Only these posts will have the right to vote at meetings of the Management Committee.

6.3- The Management Committee will be convened by the Secretary of the club and held no less than *three* per year.

6.4- The quorum required for business to be agreed at Management Committee

6.5- The Management Committee will be responsible for adopting new policy, codes of conduct and rules that affect the organisation of the club.

6.6- The Management Committee will have powers to appoint sub-committees as necessary and appoint advisers to the Management Committee as necessary to fulfil its business.

6.7- The Management Committee will be responsible for disciplinary hearings of members who infringe the club rules/regulations/constitution. The Management Committee will be responsible for taking any action of suspension or discipline following such hearings.

## 7. Finance

7.1- All club monies will be banked in an account held in the name of the club.

7.2- The Club Treasurer will be responsible for the finances of the club.

7.3- The financial year of the club will end on: *March 21<sup>st</sup>*.

7.4- An audited statement of annual accounts will be presented by the Treasurer at the Annual General Meeting.

7.5- Any cheques drawn against club funds should hold the signatures of the Treasurer plus up to two other officers.

## 8. Annual General Meetings

8.1- Notice of the Annual General Meeting (**AGM**) will be given by the Club Secretary. Not less than 21 clear days' notice to be given to all members.

8.2- The AGM will receive a report from officers of the Management Committee and a statement of the audited accounts.

8.3- Nominations for officers of the Management Committee will be sent to the Secretary prior to the AGM.

8.4- Elections of officers are to take place at the AGM.

8.5- All members have the right to vote at the AGM.

8.6- The quorum for AGMs will be 25% of the Membership present.

8.7- The Management Committee has the right to call Extraordinary General Meetings (EGMs) outside the AGM. Procedures for EGMs will be the same as for the AGM.

## 9. Discipline and appeals

9.1- All complaints regarding the behaviour of members should be submitted in writing to the Secretary.

9.2- The Management Committee will meet to hear complaints within *30* days of a complaint being lodged. The committee has the power to take appropriate disciplinary action including the termination of membership.

9.3- The outcome of a disciplinary hearing should be notified in writing to the person who lodged the complaint and the member against whom the complaint was made within *three* days of the hearing.

9.4- There will be the right of appeal to the Management Committee following disciplinary action being announced. The committee should consider the appeal within *seven* days of the Secretary receiving the appeal.

## **10. Dissolution**

10.1- A resolution to dissolve the club can only be passed at an AGM or EGM through a majority vote of the membership.

10.2- In the event of dissolution, any assets of the club that remain will become the property of *the Government of The United States of America*.

## **11. Amendments to the constitution**

11.1- The constitution will only be changed through agreement by majority vote at an AGM or EGM.

## **12. Operate as a Club Trust**

12.1: The T-ROH ALLIANCE Associate Members are beneficiaries of the Club, and

12.2: There shall be the existence of a Board of Trustees separate of the elected office holders wherein one office operates separate of the other, and

12.3- The Board of Trustees shall consist of the two or more trustees that founded the T-ROH ALLIANCE, and

12.4- The Board of Trustees shall make all final decisions and operate as a regulatory board under the classification of compliance officers to make sure all operating procedures are followed in accordance with this constitution, any by-laws passed by the members that are constitutional, and code of conduct, and

### 13: Reservation of Rights

13.1- The Trustees in its capacity as Board of Trustees reserve the right to alter, amend, or remove any part of this constitution, policy, by-law, or code on behalf of the Club and its membership in the event that a policy, by-law, code or other decision fails to produce the desired outcome as it was intended, and
