DECLARATION OF SOVEREIGNTY

USC Chamber of Commerce, (hereafter "USC") claims: Sovereignty of the USC, independence, integrity, and indivisibility of the USC's authority within the boundaries of its legal person, its activities, its properties and its independence and equality in internal and external relations doing business as a non-governmental organization; thereby supporting the Government of The United States of America through its mission and purpose.

I. Self-Determination of and Within the USC

The USC as a sovereign entity develops within its existing and expanding boundaries to exercise the USC's inalienable right to self-determination.

The USC protects and defends the sovereignty of the USC, its properties and its activities.

Any violent, unlawful, illegal and oppressive actions against the USC, its properties or its activities undertaken by national entities, intergovernmental entities, specialized agencies, political parties, other non-governmental organizations, companies, associations, other groups or individuals shall be legally prosecuted.

Executive Board Members and Permanent Members of the USC regardless of nationality, ethnicity, religion, gender, orientation, nature, age, (professional) occupation or affiliation comprise the USC.

Executive Board Members and Permanent Members of the USC are the sole source of authority in the sovereign entity.

The absolute authority of the USC is exercised directly through the sovereign entity's Articles of Organization and the Declaration of Sovereignty of the USC.

Only the representatives of the USC can represent the USC. No other national entities, intergovernmental entities, specialized agencies, political parties, non-governmental organization, companies, associations, other groups or individuals can represent the USC.

II. Legislative, Executive and Judicial Power

The USC is independent in determining any issue of its internal and external affairs.

The USC guarantees the Chain of Title of the Articles of Organization of the USC and the Declaration of Sovereignty of the USC within the boundaries of its legal person and its activities.

Authority in the USC is exercised on the principle of its division into legislative, executive, and judicial branches.

Legislative Power: Rests with the legislative branch consisting of its permanent members.

Executive Power: Rests with the Executive Board.

Judicial Power: Is exercised by the Human Rights Tribunal International.



III. Territorial Supremacy

The USC has the supremacy over its legal person, its properties and its activities.

The legal person, properties and activities of the USC within its existing and expanding boundaries are inviolable and cannot be changed, claimed, seized or used without its consent.

The USC is independent in determining the administrative and boundary systems of the sovereign entity and the procedures for establishing communication and administrative units.

IV. Economic Independence

The USC independently determines its economic status and secures it through the Declaration of Sovereignty of the USC and through the Articles of Organization of the USC.

The Executive Board Members and the Permanent Members of the USC have the exclusive right to control, use and direct the resources of the USC.

The legal person, activities and domains, its interior (intellectual resources), digital space, power supply and any other resources found within the boundaries of the USC, the exclusive (maritime) economic zone, and all economic and scientific-technical potential created within the boundaries of the USC are the property of the USC, the material basis of the entity's sovereignty, and are used to meet the purposes and the powers of the USC.

The USC guarantees protection to all forms of ownership and copyright.

The USC shall not tax and shall not establish tax collection systems.

V. Environmental Safety

The USC independently determines procedures to organize nature protection within the boundaries of the sovereign entity and procedures for the use of resources.

The USC has its own committee for protection from radiation, weather manipulation, meteorological warfare and eco-terrorism.

The USC has the right to halt and ban the operations of any businesses, entities, institutions, organizations, individuals and other objects within its boundaries that threaten the USC's environmental safety.

The USC has the right to compensation for the damages to the environment, territory, property, activities and domains within the boundaries of the USC brought about by the acts of national entities, intergovernmental entities, specialized agencies, political parties, non-governmental organizations, companies, associations, other groups or individuals.



VI. External and Internal Security

The USC has the right to its own self-defense and intelligence gathering systems.

The USC has its own bodies of self-defense and intelligence gathering subordinated to the Executive Board Members and the Permanent Members of the USC.

The USC autonomously determines procedures and purposes for self-defense and intelligence services by authorities of the USC.

The USC solemnly declares the intention of becoming:

- a permanent enforcer of policies to restore justice, public order and society as a whole
- an entity that does not participate in any military blocs and adheres to three nuclear free principles, i.e. to accept, to produce and to purchase no nuclear weapons.
- an entity that upholds the Law of Nations and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

The USC reserves the right at all time to use nuclear technology for peaceful purposes such as energy, education, development and science.

VII. International Relations

The USC, as an international law subject, can maintain direct relations with other external sovereign states, nations, communities and entities and may enter into agreements with them, may exchange diplomatic, consular and trade representatives, and may participate in the activity of international organizations to the full extent deemed necessary for effective guarantees of the USC's interests in political, economic, ecological, informational, scholarly, technical, and cultural spheres.

The USC acts as an equal participant in external and international affairs, actively promotes the reinforcement of general peace and international security based on truth, honor and peace.

The USC shall expose oppression, deception and psychological operations, war crimes, crimes against humanity, legal and illegal warfare.

The USC recognizes and pursues the prevalence of general human values over class and corporate values.



The USC respects other sovereign nations, states, entities and communities their sovereignty, territory, domains and internal laws.

Relations of the USC with other sovereign nations, states, entities and communities are built on the basis of agreements concluded on the basis of the principles of equality, mutual respect, and non-interference in internal affairs.

The USC values and pursues criticism; the open debate system; absolute freedom of expression, speech, association, religion and press.

The Declaration of Sovereignty of the USC and the Articles of Organization of the USC determine the positions of the sovereign entity for the purpose of internal and international agreements and its structure as written within this Declaration of Sovereignty shall supersede the original Articles of Organization wherein the Articles of Organization shall be amended to reflect the same.
